### Re: Home Learning

Please find attached a Home Learning Guidebook to support the use of our online learning systems in the event of school closure.

We intend to use SeeSaw as a means of communicating home learning during any period of closure. Our intention is share an overview of weekly activities by 9am on a Monday morning. This overview will outline Literacy, Numeracy, Project and PE activities to be completed during the week, where possible. Each day, by 9am, the activities on the overview will be made available either through SeeSaw or Google Classroom (KS2 only). Staff will be available during school hours to respond to the children's learning and answer any questions you may have. The attached, a Home Learning Guidebook, outlines how to access both SeeSaw and Google Classroom, including how to ask questions and provide feedback.

Today your child will bring home a Home Learning Book that can be used to complete home learning tasks. Inside the cover of the book are the passwords/QR codes your child will need to access SeeSaw (and Google Drive in KS2).

It is not our intention to send home reading books, however you can access levelled reading books on the 'Oxford Owl' website. Details regarding access to the appropriate reading book for your child are within the Home Learning guide.

Please familiarise yourself with the attached document and if you have any questions please do not hesitate to get in touch.

Clearly, these are very challenging times for all of us with a great deal of uncertainty about the immediate future. Our main concern is for the health and wellbeing of our pupils, staff and whole school community. We provide this information as a means of maintaining some sense of normality for pupils to continue with their learning. We will do our best to maintain this resource, assuming that staff are fit and well to do so.
