Childcare Provision - Hub from 29th June 2020

Dear Parents / Carers,

We hope you are all safe and well.

As you all know, on Monday 29th June we are opening our doors to the remainder of our children. This is to enable them to attend school for a limited period of time each week to: **Check-in** (with their teachers), **Catch-up** (with their peers) and **Prepare** (for transition and learning).

The LA have given us a directive that children who are in our childcare hub provision will remain in their own bubble and will not be able to join with their peers for these sessions.

Whilst many of you have expressed concerns about the arrangements from next Monday, we want you to know that our Hub children are really important to us.

We recognise the sacrifices many of you have made over the past few months and the potential knock on effect on your children. We hope you have seen that we have cared for your children and supported them to ensure the situation does not impact negatively on their wellbeing. They have had the opportunity to have the social experience that school can offer during this difficult time.

Our hub children have been absolutely fantastic throughout this challenging time.

They have arrived at school every morning with smiles on their faces and a spring in their step. They have had opportunities to mix with children from across school and to spend time with most of our teachers and teaching assistants. They have been supported in school to do their home learning and have had opportunities to engage in lots of fun outdoor activities and to develop their creativity.

We want to reassure you that our hub children **will** have opportunities to **Catch-up** with their teachers and say goodbye to them and to meet their new teachers for a **transition session**; enabling them to **Prepare** for September.

From Monday 29th June

- Hub children should still come to school for 8.30am and will need to be picked up by 3.30pm
- Dropping off and picking up will remain at the front of the school, staff will collect them from you in the usual way. Please keep to our one-way system.
