Model for returning to school 29th June 2020 (Part 3)

Please note: This information should be read alongside the information sent out on Monday 15th June and replaces the model outlined in the information sent on Thursday 18th June 2020.

Dear Parents / Carer

It was announced on the evening of Friday 19th June by the Local Authority that schools will close for the summer break on Friday 17th June. This means that our children will return to school on Monday 29th June for **3 weeks and not 4** as in the model sent on 18.6.20. As a result, we have had to revise our model as below.

Please note the changes only affect Nursery and Year 6. All other year group sessions remain the same.

Week 1	Week beginning 29th June, Reception to Year 6 in as above. No Nursery children in school
Week 2	Week beginning 6th July Transition for Reception to Year 5 as above. Year 6 only in on Friday 10th 9am - 12.30pm No Nursery children in school
Week 3	Week beginning 13th July - Reception to Year 6 in as above. All Year 6 also in on Friday 17th - 9.00am - 3.00pm. Nursery groups A, B, C, D, E & F in Monday - Wednesday see separate letter.

- **Reception to Year 5** - in school **Weeks 1, 2 and 3** in their groups A, B, C as above.



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- **Year 6 - week 1** - in their groups A, B and C as above; **week 2** in for one session on Friday (all of Year 6 in but in separate classes in their groups); **week 3** sessions A, B, C as above plus an extra session on Friday 9 - 3.00pm, last day at Glasllwch.
- **Nursery - 1 group per session during Week 3.** This will be in groups of approximately 5 with one parent, and an opportunity to meet with the Reception teacher for September.

Staggered Times

Children will come to school at staggered times and leave at staggered times to ensure parents are able to adhere to social distancing rules.

Within School Activities.

Week 1 - Children from Reception to Year 6 in school. The children will have an opportunity to: become reacquainted with school and their friends, talk about their time at home; share any concerns or worries they may have; share and celebrate the wonderful things they have been doing at home; engage in outdoor investigative learning to apply their skills in a practical way.

Week 2 - Children from Reception to Year 5 in school for transition. The children will spend time in their new classroom with their new teacher.

Year 6 will attend on Friday 10th - 9.00am - 12.30pm.

Week 3 - Children from Reception to Year 6 in school. This will be a time for children to finish the year in their classes with their friends and teachers.

Year 6 will also attend on Friday 17th 9.00am - 3.00pm - a celebration of their time at Glasllwch.

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Existing Hub Children

Our existing provision for key worker children in our Childcare Hub will also continue to run in the school hall. Start and finish times for this provision will remain the same - 8.30am - 3.30pm. Currently, Welsh Government state that if your child is in a Hub, they cannot join their peers for the 'check-in, catch-up and prepare' sessions with their teacher and transition. This situation remains unchanged. They will have a transition session with their new teacher on one afternoon.

Classroom Arrangements

- Pupils will keep their coats, snack and water bottles in their classrooms.
- There will be space to keep them on their tables.
- All children will have their own pack of resources which will be placed in a labelled zippy bag and kept on their tables, these are for individual use only.
- All resources, including chairs and tables will be thoroughly cleaned at the end of each session.

Other Key Information

- Staff and children will follow WG guidance in relation to health and safety, hygiene and social distancing.
- Please talk to your child before coming to school about the importance of regular handwashing and adhering to social distancing rules.
- Children will remain in their groupings for all activities and break times and will not have contact with other groups in school.
- We will be using the outdoor environment as much as possible as this is the safest place to be as well as the best place to be to have fun!
- Please make sure your child comes to school with sunscreen already applied and a sun hat.
