Dear Parents / Carers

We are doing all we can to help assist with social distancing whilst you are on the school site by staggering arrival and finish times of classes and allowing siblings to arrive at the later class time for each family and be picked up at 3.15pm.

Please could you help us by arriving as close as possible to the arrival and collection times - not too early, so as not to be waiting on the playground. Once you have seen your child line up or enter the school we ask that you leave the playground via the vehicle exit route. When dropping off or collecting please use all of the playground to space yourselves out, both sides of our divide line, to again help with social distancing. Once your child has been released to you at the end of the day, again, please leave straight away.

Please **do not wait at the entrance to the playground** as this creates a barrier for others coming in or leaving.

If, for some reason you are waiting, please do not let your child/children run around or play games, so they can avoid mixing with others or bumping into people. We also have to request that when waiting on the playground you **do not wait under our shelter area** by the hall, as this is too close to the school building, we ask that you keep a safe distance away, thank you.

Due to the way we have to keep class groups apart when dismissing them, on rainy days our **Reception class** will be dismissed from under our shelter area on the playground.

Please pass this information on to whoever picks your children up from school so everyone understands our procedures.

Thank you for helping us keep our school community safe during this challenging time.
