School's responsibilities are to:

- Provide a safe, secure, caring and stimulating environment
- Treat all children fairly, equally and with respect

- Provide a creative curriculum that is accessible, appropriately challenging and engaging
- Ensure that each child is given opportunities to achieve his / her full potential
- Value the natural curiosity and voice of each individual
- Expect high standards of work, achievement and behaviour
- Deal with any incidents of bullying, harassment, prejudice or inappropriate behaviour
- Ensure pupils are taught about esafety; the responsible and safe use of technology including the internet
- Enable each child to develop a sense of responsibility and belonging within our school community
- Ensure good communication and arrange opportunities to discuss your child's progress and behaviour

Parents' / Carers' responsibilities are to:

- Ensure your child attends school and is on time
- Inform school as soon as possible of the reason for your child's absence
- Ensure your child treats all members of our school community with respect
- Work in partnership with school to support your child's learning, including home learning
- Support the school's values and rules for behaviour
- Attend meetings to discuss your child's progress and behaviour
- Keep school up to date with contact details and medical information
- Ensure your child is appropriately equipped for school (e.g. school uniform, P.E. kit, reading book, homework, musical instrument)
- Ensure that you understand and agree the school's approach to esafety
- Ensure that both you and your child behave safely and considerately on the school grounds and in the area outside school
- Ensure you park in a safe place outside school, not obstructing the school gates or residents driveways
- Ensure your child is toilet trained before starting school unless there are specific difficulties

Children's responsibilities are to:

- Come to school regularly and on time
- Respect all staff, other adults and children
- Follow the school rules
- Try your best and become fully involved in your learning
- Tell an adult if you or anyone else is unhappy or being ill-treated
- Follow the school esafety rules
- Care for your own and the school's property and possessions
- Treat the school grounds and building with respect and to care and look after the environment
